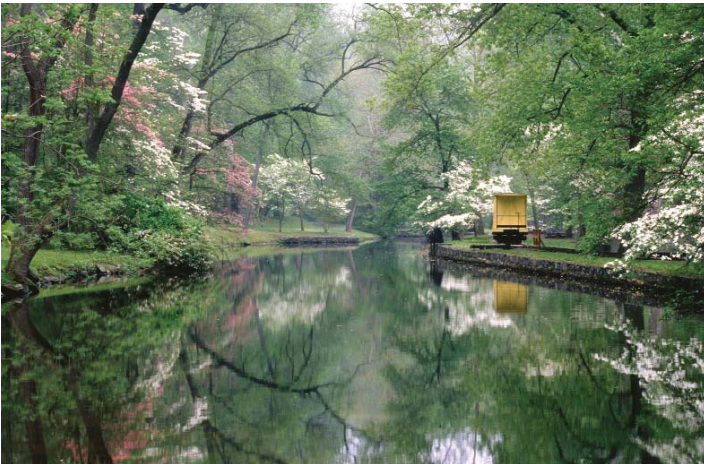


# Art & Gunpowder!

## One Day Group Tour Itinerary



## Experience the Delaware Art Museum and Hagley Museum and Library

Explore the Delaware Art Museum, home to a world-renowned collection of art, and Hagley Museum and Library, the original du Pont family home and gunpowder works.

Begin your day with a tour of the captivating collection of the **Delaware Art Museum**. Explore the Museum's collection of 19th-century **British Pre-Raphaelite art**—the largest in the country—as well as an extensive collection of **American art and illustration**. Afterwards, enjoy a delicious lunch in the Museum's contemporary East Court. Then you will travel to **Hagley Museum and Library**, where the du Pont story begins. In 1802, a young French immigrant, E. I. du Pont, found the Brandywine River to be the perfect spot to build his black powder mills and establish the DuPont Company.

### *Hagley Museum and Library – The Brandywine Tour*

Enjoy a two hour guided visit to Eleutherian Mills, the du Pont family ancestral home, a restored 19th-century French-style garden, and the First Office of the DuPont Company. You may also visit the powder

yard and see demonstrations of how water power was used in early industry. *(Cost is \$8 per person for groups of 15 or more)*
