Thanks to you and your thoughtfulness, care, and generosity, 2017 was a year of change and progress for your Museum.

Under the leadership of our Board of Trustees, we turned our attention to creating an inclusive and vibrant vision and strategic direction. Our dedicated Board, donors, instructors, volunteers, and staff began implementation of a 360-degree approach to community and civic engagement, with our collections as the crown jewel.

This exciting new strategic direction requires that we increase our value and relevance to all audiences—particularly our underserved audiences—to generate the trust and confidence in the Museum that will drive our long-term financial sustainability. And we see this coming to pass. Gerret and Tatiana Copeland's transformative fifteen million dollar pledge at the start of 2018 demonstrates a love for what this museum has been over the last century, but also confidence in the groundwork you helped us to lay in 2017 toward our new vision for the future.

While planning for the future, we realized significant successes. We added 238 new artworks to our collection and put forth three spectacular major exhibitions: *Wonder & Whimsy: The Illustrations of W. Heath Robinson*, *The Original Mad Man: Illustrations by Mac Conner* (the artist, now 103, visited the exhibition and was thrilled by our installation), and the first full-career retrospective of John Sloan's

work since 1988: *An American Journey: The Art of John Sloan*. Additionally, we continued work on our project to digitize our entire collection, generously funded by the Institute of Museum and Library Services. To date we have made more than 10,000 objects searchable on our website. Our members, scholars, and the general public now have digital access to these works even when they're not on view in our galleries.

We are well on our way to establishing the Museum as a vital hub. Last year, attendance exceeded 80,000 – the most in a decade. We served 29,267 youth and adults through a wide range of programs and events. And, 2017 was the highest earning year for the Studio Art Program—surpassing anticipated income by \$19,000. Thanks in part to an outstanding fall push, the Museum Store closed out 2017 with a \$5,000 increase over 2016 sales. And last summer, hundreds of our neighbors and visitors enjoyed Thursday Happy Hours on our terrace by the Copeland Sculpture Garden.

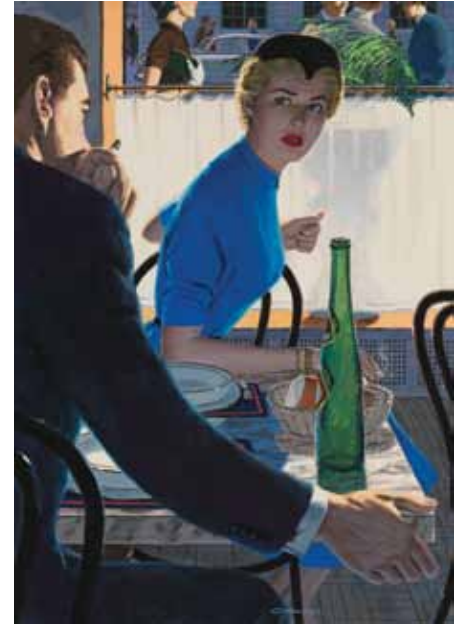

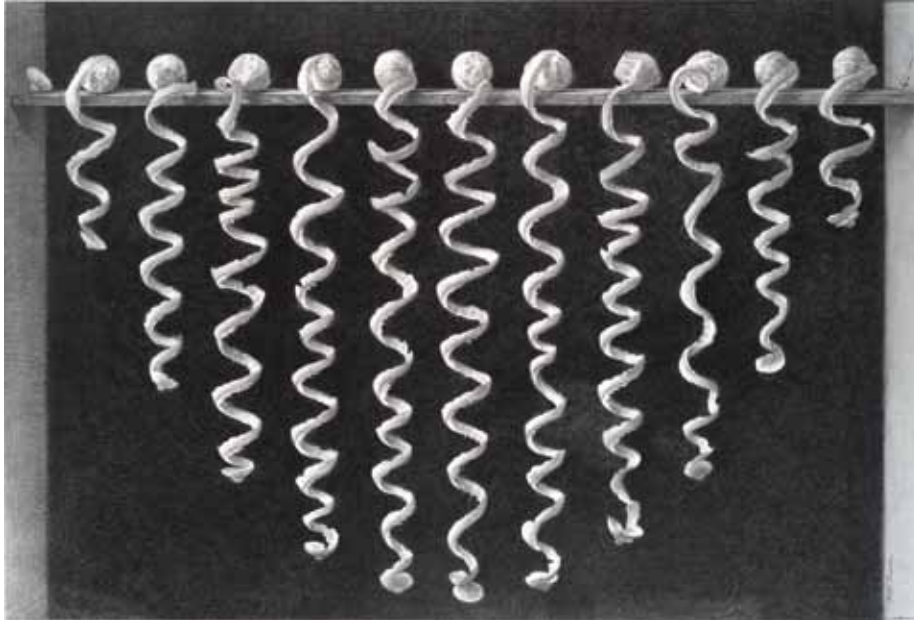
